### VI. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

GENERAL: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Keweenaw County Building Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

#### VII. Mobile Home unit

ITEM #17, MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee, service, plus the number of park sites. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee and a feeder. This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or premanufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service and feeder.

A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND/OR CONDUCTED WITHIN <u>SIX MONTHS</u> OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CAN BE REOPENED FOR A FEE OF \$75.00.
