Steven opened the meeting at 6:40 pm.

Ray reported that Keweenaw Copper is still interested in the Mt. Horace Greeley site. A building lease agreement is under discussion with the county, with the possibility of more in the future. The county lawyer has suggested that she should go after the Air Force about site clean up. The commercial buildings on the site belong to the county. UP Power has removed electric service to the site and wants to charge to bring it back.

Michael will be getting Marlin's Authority information soon and hand it over to the county clerk.

Bill stated that a BEA for Mt. Horace Greeley would make Keweenaw Copper harmless. Ray will ask WUPPDR to write a grant for a baseline assessment of the site. Bill has contacted Amy Keranen of MDEQ and she provided contact information for the Air Force and the Army Corp of Engineers. Ray mentioned that the GSA has the site houses and wants nothing to do with the clean up. Ray will provide Bill with his GSA contact information. Michael suggested contacting federal elected officials.

The Gay Sands and the Louisiana-Pacific sited were discussed. Bill will contact Louisiana-Pacific to get an update on their site monitoring and future use.
