Smith Fisheries already has two important public features that should remain open to the public, Michigan Nature Associations Bare Bluff and the State of Michigan Lands around the Montreal River. He would like to create a trail head with parking approximately 1.5 miles before the fisheries for access to the State Land and eventually ADA access to the falls.

Jack Treganowan supported Marks idea. Kathy McEvers suggested asking the trail clubs to weigh in as well

Commission Final Comments – Richard Schaefer suggested that Mark call Greg at the Road Commission and ask to be placed on the agenda for the September 13th meeting which is held at 2:00 PM for discussion regarding inclusion into the Future Land Use Plan.
